Abstract:

The goals of the North Rose-Wolcott Central School District (NRW CSD) STLE grant are:

1. Increase retention of effective teachers and administrators.
2. Improve ratings on key practice components of NRW CSD's teacher rubric, "Teachscape: the Framework for Teaching" Revised 2011.
3. Improve student academic achievement through the development of highly effective school leaders and teachers by June 30, 2014.
4. Achieve a funding sustainability plan for the continuation of the STLE program by September 2013.

These will be accomplished through the following objectives:

- a) Four school and district leaders will be provided leadership development and training.
- b) Two administrative interns will complete "Leader Development" by June 30, 2014.
- c) All district teachers will be provided APPR supports.
- d) Retention of highly effective teachers will increase 10% by June 30, 2014.
- e) Teachers will increase their ability to develop SLOs, common core, and non-regents curriculum.
- f) STLE efforts will be sustained and NRW CSD will provide training, coaching, and ongoing support to current and future leaders and teachers.

Strategy: NRW CSD will provide differentiated training, coaching, and ongoing support to improve ratings of key practice components of our rubric. The district will work to develop sources of funding for continued participation in the STLE program through application to funding sources local and federal, and through collaboration and partnerships.

Outcomes:

- a) Increase student growth/value-added measures, as applied to state assessments, in grades 4-8 ELA and Math by 10%.
- b) Increase credits earned by 9th and 10th graders by 5%.

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
