### **Grantee Information:**

### **Abstract:**

The initiatives the district is funding are:

- A professional learning community, A-PLUSS: Academy of Peer Learning, United for Student Success.
- Establishment of career ladders for teachers and building-level administrators, each with three rungs – an element of the TLE continuum that had previously been missing in the district.
- Outside professional development to support an instructional “help desk” that relies on turnkey training.

**Goal #1:** Establish a professional learning community among Broadalbin-Perth teachers and school building leaders to improve teacher and school leader effectiveness in the district.

**Goal #2:** Increase student achievement through more effective teaching and school leadership practices throughout the district.

These initiatives will positively affect every student in the district, including students who are economically disadvantaged and who have disabilities (Broadalbin-Perth’s highest-need students).
