Abstract:

The STLE 3 grant will allow the Fulton City School District an opportunity to build a career ladder framework that supports research-based implementation of the CCLS on its way to establishing a high-performing district/culture. To address gaps in the TLE continuum, the Fulton City School District grant will focus on building teacher/leader capacity in data-driven instruction through targeted professional development and job-embedded skill coaching.

This will be accomplished by:

- K-12 active participation in professional development activities that build a common language and understanding of data-driven instruction, STEM and project based learning, technology integration, and establishing a growth mindset. Professional development activities will benefit both teachers and administrators.
- Identification and training of one ELA and one Math Instructional Coach to provide peer-to-peer support in the implementation of Common Core modules and data-driven instructional practices
- Training of one Technology Instructional Coach to support teachers as they integrate technology and 21st century skills into their daily instruction

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
