SAT® is a rigorous, national assessment for 11th and 12th graders that assesses ELA and Mathematics. The College Board is a not-for-profit membership organization whose mission is to connect students to college success and opportunity. The College Board works with over 5,700 schools, colleges, universities, and other educational organizations, serves more than seven million students and parents and 3,800 colleges and universities in over 180 countries and territories, as well as policymakers on the national and state levels. The College Board also maintains relationships with more than 900 key school districts across the country. College Board services pertinent to this RFQ include assessments such as AP®, ReadStep®, PSAT/NMSQT®, ACCUPLACER®, SAT®, and SAT Subject tests. In addition to its main offices, the College Board maintains six regional offices to better serve schools and districts nationwide. The Middle States Regional Office serves the state of New York. Staff at the national and regional levels will provide the services necessary to provide SAT® to districts state wide. The College Board provided SAT® assessments to approximately 1.6 million students in the 2010 cohort worldwide. The College Board has the capacity to provide SAT® all 11th and 12th grade students in the state of New York.
