

Estimated Service Costs

Below is an outline for the adoption and implementation of the Classroom Assessment Scoring System™ (CLASS™) for observation and evaluation of the quality of teacher-child interactions. Also provided below are the estimated associated fees and costs as of June 17, 2011. These estimates are based on the experience and product offerings of Teachstone Training, LLC. Overview

Each trained Observer can evaluate one or two teachers per day (each evaluation takes approximately two hours and must be conducted during instructional time). Observers are trained either at a "regional training event" (training for individual participants, hosted by Teachstone at locations across the country, or "onsite" (group training hosted by an LEA), both of which are coordinated and delivered by Teachstone. Observations require Scoring Sheets, also provided by Teachstone.

Description and Costs

1. Onsite training for up to 15 participants:
 - a. Two-day training event \$4,000 + Teachstone trainer travel
 - b. CLASS Manual \$49.95 per participant
 - c. Scoring Sheet \$28.00 for pack of ten
(one sheet per participant required for training)

2. Regional Training Attendance (travel and lodging for participants not included)
 - a. Two-day attendance \$670.00 per participant

3. Scoring Sheets for Observations \$28.00 per pack of ten
